ADMISSIONS PROCESS



We are pleased with your interest in our institution, Edinburg Theological Seminary. ETS is part of a consortium of theological and Christian graduate schools that have been serving Christ and His community in the areas of graduate-level higher education, research and publications, since 1948.

Enclosed you will find all the forms needed to apply. It is highly recommended that prospective students begin the application process at least two months before the semester begins, which is in September (Fall Semester) and January (Spring Semester). If you need more information regarding our academic plans and programs, tuition, payment, scholarships, or have any questions concerning this application, please do not hesitate to contact the Admissions Department.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

A. *Application Form*: Please fill out the application form and return it to the Admissions Department along with the appropriate application fee.

A. *References*: ETS requires at least three references from persons other than relatives, such as your current or former pastor, teacher, employer, or a non-family friend. After filling out the top portion of these reference forms, give them directly to those whom you are requesting a reference. These forms should be mailed directly to the Admissions Department by the person completing the form.

OTHER REQUIREMENTS

A. Academic Transcript(s): Please attain a transcript from each college or university you have attended. Unless otherwise noted, unofficial transcripts will be acceptable. Please mail all transcripts to the Admissions Department.

B. *Reading Summary:* You are required to read "Man in God's World" by Paul Schrotenboer and write a short summary (one or two pages).

C. *Interview with Admissions Committee*: A personal interview with the Admissions Committee will be scheduled upon receiving your application.

NOTIFICATION OF ADMISSION

Once all admission requirements have been met, the Admissions Committee will evaluate your application and you will receive notification of our decision within 2-4 weeks.

SCHOLARSHIPS AND GRANTS

Students may apply for scholarships only after they have been accepted in ETS. Applications for scholarships can be requested from the Office of Admissions and Registrar.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

The Admissions Department will notify the student of any outstanding requirements, however please make every effort to see that all forms are promptly forwarded to the appropriate department. Your application will not be considered until all necessary items have been received.

Upon acceptance, you will receive a letter of acceptance from the ETS Dean of Administration, a course registration packet, and the date and time of orientation. All additional information will be given during this time so your attendance is required.
